

XVII REGATTA IN MEMORY OF MAREK GOSIENIECKI

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

DATE and PLACE:

11 September 2016, Bronte Harbour, Fisherman's Wharf

RULES:

The Race will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association when they apply.

COURSE:

Start and finish as per diagram page 2. Start and finish line will be an extension of straight line between two lighthouses as shown on the diagram. Start and finish mark may be placed approx. 1/4 NM from the marina lighthouse.

Course mark is CCIW Tower to be rounded to port. CCIW Yellow Tower position: 43.16.22N, 79.45.58W.

ELIGIBILITY:

All boats will require current PHRF certificate, if not PHRF rating will be assigned to the boat by the race committee.

Three classes are planned (min. 3 boats to be registered in class);

- Spinnaker Fleet
- White Sails Fleet, PHRF \leq 200
- White Sails Fleet, PHRF $>$ 200

SKIPPER'S MEETING:

Skippers meeting will be held at 9:30 AM at Fisherman's Wharf.

STARTING SEQUENCE:

Race will be started using RRS 26, with all the boats starting together at 5 minutes. Warning signal at 10:55. Starting line will be a line drawn from Oakville Pier to the Start Mark. The applicable channel for VHF communication is Channel 72.

FINISH:

Boats will record their finish time and text to: 905-483-7294

Boats withdrawing from the race shall also text to: 905-483-7294

PRICES:

The price giving ceremony will take place at YC "Zawisza Czarny" annual Captain's Ball on 01 October 2016.
